What are the hours of operation at Loudoun Pediatric Associates?

We are open 7 days a week! The office is only closed for the six major holidays (New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas). We are available to you on-call EVERY DAY of the year for emergencies, even on holidays.

Normal business hours by office location:

- Lansdowne 7:30 am – 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday
- Purcellville 7:30 am – 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday
- Stone Springs 8:00 am – 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday

*Please note that phone service begins at 8:30 am in all offices.

Walk-in hours by office location: (Please note these are temporarily suspended due to COVID).

- Lansdowne 7:30 am – 8:30 am Monday thru Friday
- Purcellville 7:30 am – 8:30 am Monday thru Friday
- Stone Springs 8:00 am – 9:00 am Monday thru Friday

*No appointment is needed for these walk-in appointments. These are for same-day sick/acute visits that just developed the night before or the morning of the visit. Chronic issues will NOT be addressed in this fast paced/urgent care setting, but we are happy to offer you a scheduled appointment. This service is for ESTABLISHED patients only. Walk-ins during regular business hours will be scheduled for our first available appointment and/or be evaluated by our triage nurse.

Are you open on the weekends?

Yes, we are! We understand that children need access to medical care every day of the week, not just Monday – Friday.

- Saturday hours 9:00 am – 12:00 pm in Lansdowne, by appointment only
- Sunday hours 9:00 am – 12:00 pm in Purcellville, by appointment only

Do you have same-day sick visits available?

Yes, we keep our schedules open so that there is availability for same-day sick visits. You are always free to request which provider you would like to see, but given the time limitation, the doctor you requested may not be available. For physicals, you may schedule in advance and request the provider of your choosing.

What do I do if I have a question during the day?

You can call the office and speak with our triage nurse during normal business hours. We also have a 'warm line' for breastfeeding mothers with non-urgent issues where you can leave a message and one of our certified lactation consultants will return your call within 24 hours. The phone number for the 'warm line' is (703) 723-7337.

What do I do if I have an after-hours emergency?

You can find many answers to questions on our website. If there are other emergencies where you need to speak with the on-call provider, you can call our answering service at (703) 257-3932 and a provider will call you back within 15-30 minutes. There is a \$10 charge per call that covers the cost of our answering service.

How many providers do you have?

We have 7 pediatricians who are all board certified by the American Academy of Pediatrics as well as 4 Certified Nurse Practitioners, 1 Certified Physician's Assistant and 1 Certified Lactation Consultant.

What on-site laboratory services do you have at your offices?

We provide laboratory services by doing most blood work in our offices without sending you to an outside facility. We also perform same-day tests for strep throat, Influenza A & B, RSV, cholesterol, hemoglobin, glucose, and urinalysis.

What types of visits are available at your office?

- Breastfeeding Services and Newborn Check-ups
- Sports Physicals
- Well Baby and Well Child Check-ups
- Sick Visits (with same day availability)
- Travel Consultations and Vaccines
- Immunizations and Flu vaccines
- Weight and Nutrition Management
- Asthma Management including Pulmonary Function Tests/Spirometry
- ADHD Consultations and Management
- Behavior Consultations
- Sleep Consultations
- Adoption Consultation Services

What is your policy on vaccinations?

We follow the guidelines of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and Centers for Disease Control (CDC). We do not delay immunizations, nor do we allow alternative schedules. We are proud of our 100% vaccination policy and we do not allow nonvaccinated patients to continue with our practice. We are happy to discuss vaccinations with you at any of your child's visits.

Do you see patients in the hospital?

Our providers are affiliated with Inova Loudoun Hospital, but we do not round on your baby while they are in the hospital. Your newborn baby will be seen by an expert team of Neonatology Specialists that have continuous coverage in the hospital. We are able to follow remotely via the EPIC charting system and through direct communication with the neonatologists.

Additionally, if your child needs to go to the emergency room or be admitted to the hospital, we use the hospitalist services at Inova Loudoun Hospital. These board certified pediatric hospitalists specialize in inpatient care and are on site at the hospital 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. The hospitalists manage your care in the hospital, while discussing details with us on the phone and through electronic chart communication.

Do you have Electronic Medical Records?

Yes, we have an Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system that allows us to access your child's chart from any of our locations and remotely.

We are expecting a new baby and want to know what our first step is.

We are very happy you are considering us to be your child's pediatrician! Simply complete your preregistration paperwork at the hospital and specify that Loudoun Pediatric Associates will be your baby's pediatric office. Before your baby's discharge date, please call one of our offices to schedule your first appointment with 1-2 days of discharge.

When is our first visit with our new baby?

We like to see all newborn patients within 1-2 days after discharge from the hospital. For our new nursing mothers, we encourage you to also make an appointment with our Lactation Consultant for your first visit so that a feeding assessment can be done, in addition to the routine newborn management.

When will our newborn get their first vaccine?

We encourage you to get the Hepatitis B vaccine for your baby while you are in the hospital for the birth. If you prefer, your baby will receive this first vaccination at the first office visit.

Will our baby receive any other treatments in the hospital?

It is routine for your baby to receive Vitamin K and Erythromycin eye ointment in the hospital, and also to have a newborn screen and hearing screen performed. We require that all of these treatments be performed per routine in the hospital in order for your baby to be accepted into our practice.

Are there any vaccines that we need as parents?

We encourage all parents to be immunized according to the Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines. Especially for parents of newborns, we recommend that both parents and any caregivers receive the Tdap vaccine and their yearly influenza vaccine.

When are Well Baby/Well Child Visits and what shots go along with each visit?
